# NOMINEE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The LeadershipHQ Outstanding Leadership Awards acknowledge the impact of Australia's best leaders; therefore, leaders must be Australian citizens and working in an Australian-based business.

All nominees, other than student and future leaders, must have held a leadership role for at least 24 months.

Future and student leaders must be able to demonstrate their leadership efforts over the last 12 months.

Nominees must belong to a properly registered Australian business, not for profit or company except for Student Leaders. This includes sole traders.

# NOMINATION CRITERIA

Nominations must be submitted in a PDF document and should contain the following for both yourself and your nominee: Name, email, phone number, organisation and role. Two referees must be supplied along with name, email and business phone number and mobile.

Submission must not exceed 1000 words and please focus on WHY you do what they do when answering the following questions:

*NOTE\* Videos, media and or articles may accompany the submission.*

# JUDGING CRITERIA

Each Judge will score out of ten based on how well the criteria is addressed. Ensure you address the following criteria when answering the questions:

Authenticity – The leader has acted according to clearly expressed personal values and beliefs.

Impact – The leader has created new, innovative ideas and strategies, while not being afraid to question current processes.

Inclusive – The leader has clearly contributed to developing an organisational culture that values diversity and inclusiveness.

Courage – The leader has shown leadership courage by being brave in all aspects of their lives.
